1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Information was collected during several meetings throughout the school year. Parent groups involved in giving input were: Parent Teacher Organization (PTO), English Learner Advisory Committee (ELAC), and the Charter School Advisory Committee (CSAC). Meetings for PTO and ELAC were conducted monthly and the CSAC met three times. Recommendations to purchase new equipment for the Multi Purpose Room (MPR) came from all three groups after our Winter Sing, Spring Sing, and our production of 101 Dalmatians Kids. Though parent, community, and teacher feedback it is clear that our existing sound equipment in the MPR is not adequate for the performances that we have at DMCS. All three parent groups wanted new audio equipment for the Multi Purpose Room so that the audience could better hear the students who were performing. They all wanted the Executive Director to find quotes and to use grant money to fund the sound upgrade.
